1. AI Copier LTD. PRIVACY AND SECURITY POLICY

2. COMMITMENT

AIC is committed to protecting the privacy of all personal information which it obtains from you, including the information obtained during your visits to this website or the provision of other services to you. AIC will only use your personal information in accordance with this Privacy and Security Policy and otherwise in accordance with the Privacy and Data Protection Act in Santa Lucia.

3. AI Copier COLLECT PERSONAL INFORMATION

AIC collects certain personal information in order that it may meet the needs of its customers. By collecting certain personal information, AIC can monitor and improve the services which it offers to its existing and potential customers . We will use this information for the following purposes: establishing and maintaining your account, providing our services to you, improving our services, regulatory notifications and marketing.

4. WHAT INFORMATION DOES AI Copier OBTAIN?

AIC will collect and hold information about you when you complete an online application or other type of form or access and trade on your account through this website or another service, we provide to you. AIC may derive information from your use of this website or another service we provide to you and may store this information with your personal profile. 5. HOW WILL AI Copier USE THIS INFORMATION?

- to create anonymized statistical data.

You consent to AIC using your personal information for the above- stated purposes. You also consent to AIC transferring your personal information out of Saint Lucia where this is necessary for AIC to fulfill its contractual obligations to you. Please note that AIC only transfers personal information to organizations out of Saint Lucia if AIC has assessed the organization as having appropriate controls and safeguards in place to protect your personal data.

6. WHO MAY AIC DISCLOSE THIS INFORMATION TO?

AIC may be required to provide your personal information to the regulator and government bodies from time to time. AIC may also disclose your personal information to:

- financial institutions and other similar organizations that deal within the course of its corporate activities, or those that are nominated by you.
- external service providers and professional advisers (which may be located overseas) that provide services to AIC .
- any organization at your request or any persons acting on your behalf, including your financial adviser, broker, solicitor or accountant.
- any third parties where this is necessary to process a transaction or provide services which you have requested; or
- any authority to whom AIC is required to disclose such information by law. Please note that AIC does not sell or provide your personal information to third parties for marketing purposes.

7. UPDATING YOUR INFORMATION

You may inform AIC at any time that your personal details have changed or that you wish **AIC delete personal information we hold about you by emailing us . AIC will change or delete your personal information in accordance with your instructions, except to the extent that we are required to hold your personal information for regulatory or legal purposes, to provide you with the services you have requested or to maintain adequate business records.**

8. LINKS

9. COOKIES

AIC uses cookies to gather information about your access to this website and other services we provide to you. If you have a request, please contact us to obtain a subject access request form.

We may charge a nominal fee to cover the cost of verifying the application and locating, retrieving, reviewing and copying any material requested.
